The Europe Africa Personalised Medicine (EU-Africa PerMed) second stakeholder workshop will take place on 20-21 February 2023 in Cape Town South Africa. The event has attracted more than 100 registered key representatives from Africa and Europe.

Thisstakeholder workshop will provide an opportunity to reflect on the findings from prior activities carried out by EU-Africa PerMed namely: 1. Review the Personalised medicine landscape in Africa, 2. Validate and refine the gaps and needs identified for developing areas of interest, 3. Validate and refine areas of mutual interest between Africa and Europe, 4. Understand the importance, challenges and opportunities as well as to develop models of collaboration between Africa and Europe (governance, funding, partnerships, training program, etc.) and 5. Reflect on collaboration models for developing Personalised medicine in Africa and African regions (governance, funding, partnerships, training program, etc.).

The results of the workshop will feed into the project activities of carrying out the identification and collection of areas of mutual interest between Africa and Europe and validation of results already obtained in the course of the project. The workshop outcomes will furthermore be considered for the Action Plan for African-European collaboration in personalised medicine developed by EU-Africa PerMed.
