

2nd EU-Africa PerMed Summer School Implementation of Personalised Medicine

May 21 - 23, 2024, Nairobi Kenya

The EU- Africa PerMed project is opening a call for the 2nd EU- Africa PerMed Summer School. The Summer School, part of the Africa PerMed project funded by the European Commission's Horizon 2020 program, aims to integrate African institutions into the International Consortium for Personalized Medicine and enhance collaborations between African and European countries in personalized medicine (PM).

This interactive training event, or "Summer School," will be the second inperson training event of the EU Africa PerMed project. These training events are a platform for sharing insights and experiences in PM research in both regions and to share and discuss examples of EU – Africa PM collaborations. The Summer Schools also aim to foster collaboration in PM research between EU and African research teams, providing an opportunity for networking among participants and lecturers. Lectures on key topics are followed by group work where participants analyze a case study, respond to a questionnaire, or perform other interactive work with their peers. Prior to the training event, participants are provided with a bibliography on the topics to be covered. At the end of the event, participants must pass a short exam on the content of the lectures to obtain their certificate of attendance.

The second Summer School, scheduled for May 21-23, 2024, in Nairobi, Kenya, will focus on implementing PM in various fields, aiming to equip participants with skills to support PM implementation and research network creation. The Summer School (hybrid format) is open to around 35 junior researchers, policymakers, and healthcare workers from EU and African countries who will be evaluated and admitted on a competitive basis (distributed online and face to face). At least 6 participants will be selected to receive a travel and accommodation grant. Participation in this training event is free of cost.
